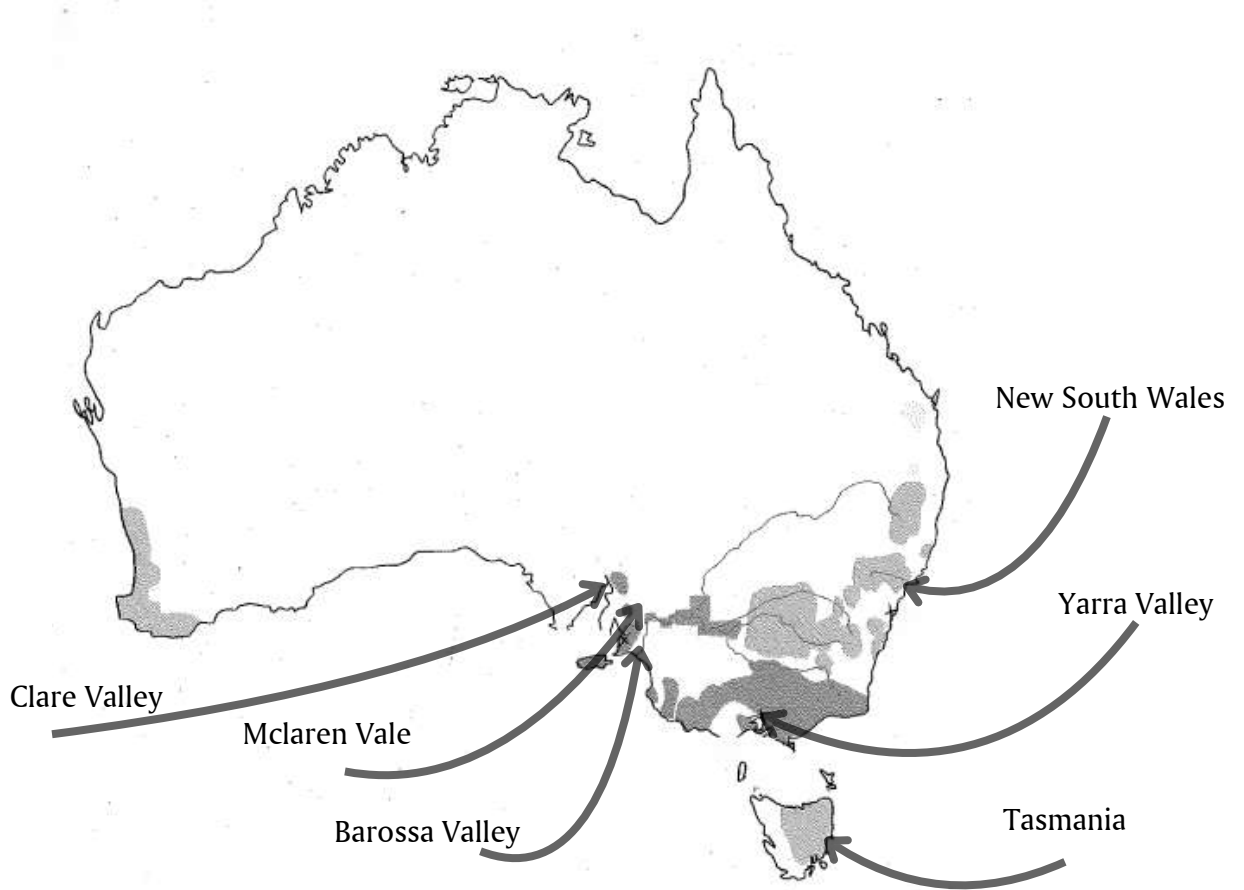

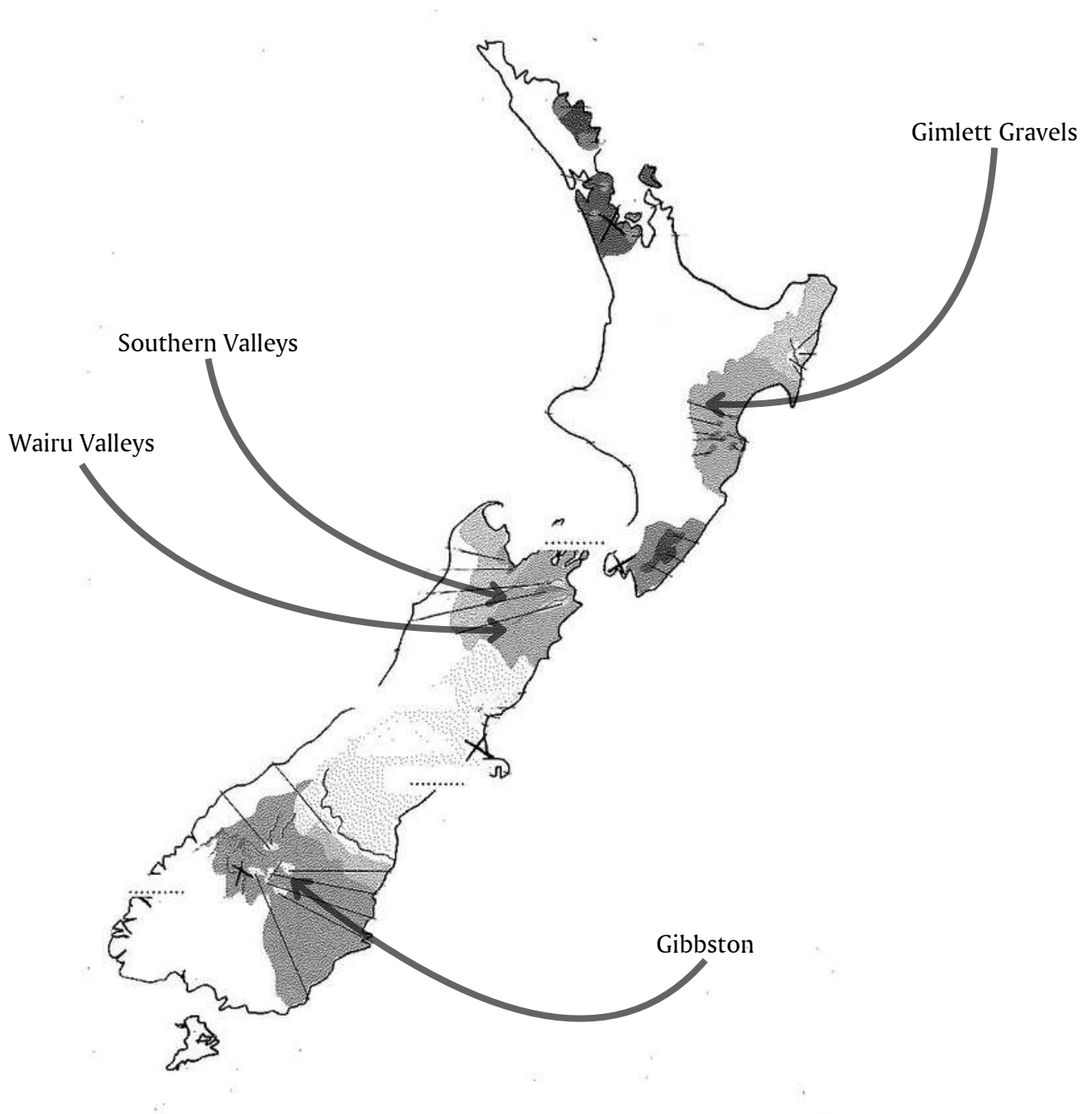
Just Chardonnay – the Shape-Shifter

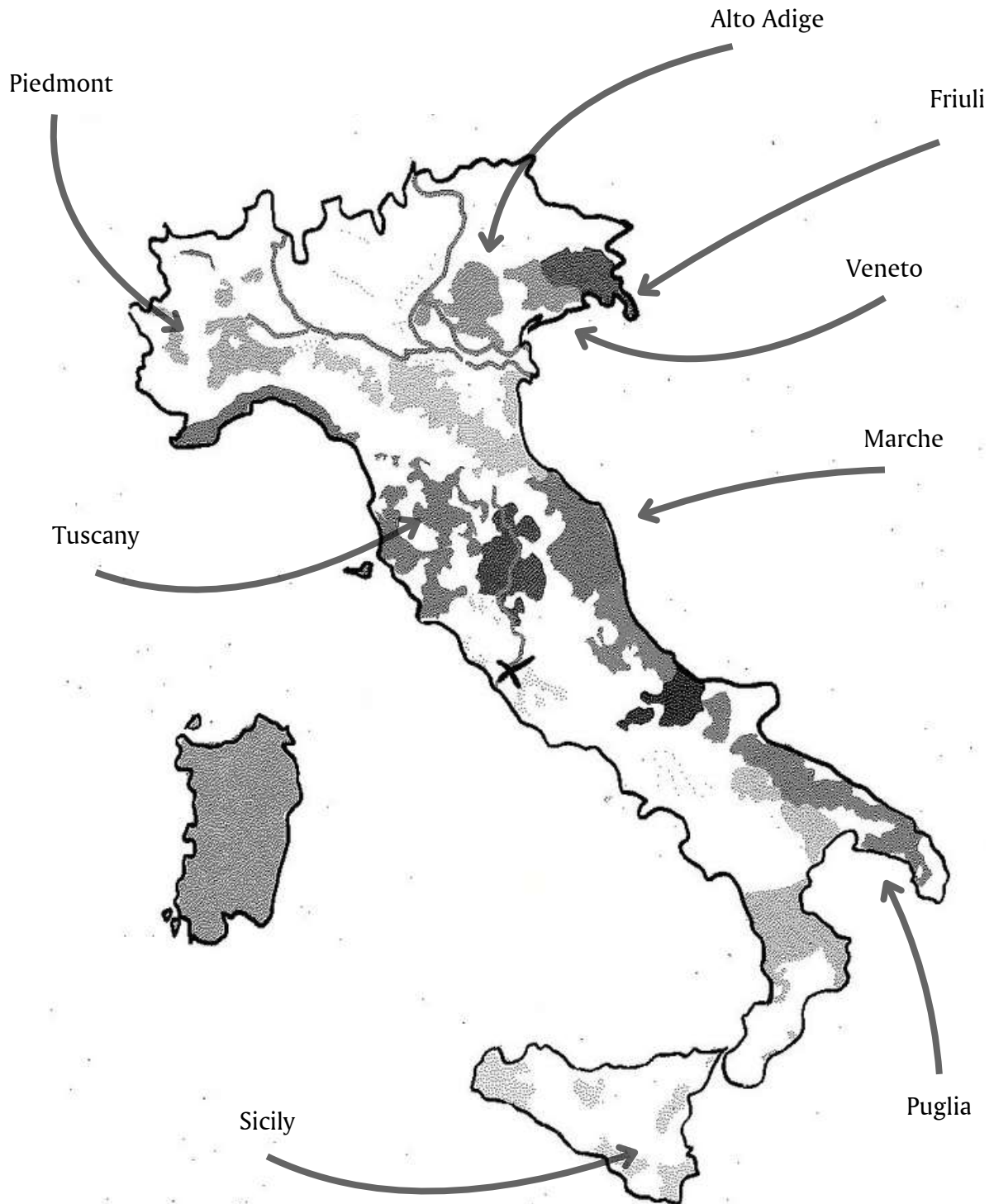
